It is also worth noting that on 7th September 2009 senator Chris Evans, the Minister for Immigration and Citizenship, announced a requirement that temporary skilled overseas workers are paid market salary rates. This will ensure that subclass 457 visa holders are on the same wages and conditions of employment as those provided to an Australian worker undertaking the same role in the workplace. Employers have until January 2010 to comply or face large fines.
